
Mrs, Etta Balla Arnovitch

FUR MAN FAILS Alleged Scheme Against Arnovitch Results In \$360 Judgment

'SKIN' GAME ON

What is alleged to have been an attempt to "flim-flam" a Winnipeg fur dealer, by means of a "skin' game, was defeated in the county court today, when Judge Paterson gave an order compelling the Great Northern Express Company to pay into court \$360 in connection with a shipment of furs.

The facts, as outlined by J. M Isaacs, barrister, are as follows: Sam Arnovitch, fur dealer, of King street and James street, sold \$3,000 worth of furs to Jacob Adeler, a New York buyer. The transaction was effected through Solomon Shapiro, Adeler's traveiling agent.

The furs were shipped to New York. Arnovitch discovered when it was too lait that he had for sotten to attach a sight draft to the bill of lading, Accordingly Adeler obtained to pay for them.

novitch paid the money. Before it could leave the city, however, his lawyer took out a writ of garnishee against Adeler and served it on the Express company. Judgment was obtained for the full amount.

In five days if there is no contest, Arnovitch will be able to collect it.

Farmers Not Worried By Labor Shortage

Farmers in the Beulah and Newdale districts are not alarmed over the labor situation, according to reports submitted to the department of agriculture today by W. R. Roberts. field representative, who is inspecting a number of agricultural centres.

Many of the farmers in the Beulah district have married couples working for them, Mr. Roberts reports, and most of the Newdale farmers have already secured their help. In some cases Galicians who were kept all winter by farmers left as soon as the spring demand for farm help developed. These men refused to work for less than \$55 a month and their keep.


Sam Arnovitch: estate

- ✓ \$2141.23 + court taxes.



Sam Arnovitch: estate

- ✓ \$1188.03 owed by furauction firm.
- ✓ 688 muskrat skins (worth \$584.80).
- Personal effects: watch; lighter; handbag; \$61.63 (paid to Paperman for the funeral).



Sam Arnovitch: estate

- Winnipeg lawyer gained administration of Sam's estate.
- ✓ Half went to plaintiff.
- Half was the "solicitor's disbursement."



- ✓ What reduced Sam to zero?
- ✓ Why did he come back to the city of his birth after 60+ years only to die 2 weeks later?
